3. Admissions Process

Step 1

If you are a professional, carer, parent, or potential learner you can download an application form from our Works4U website [Apply Now - Works4U](#) and email it to referrals@normanmackie.com

Step 2

Arrange a visit as soon possible by calling our college on 0161 303 1069 we hold regular open days for the learner/parents/carers/professionals to attend Works4U for an initial meeting so we can get to know you, how we can help and to give you a real insight of Works4U's learning experience. Taster sessions are planned if needed. Please bring the latest copy of your EHCP.

Step 3

If the learners' needs can be met by our college and they are happy to join Works4U, we can offer you a place by writing to you, which you need to confirm(subject to funding from your local authority). We can then apply to your local authority to commission your funding.

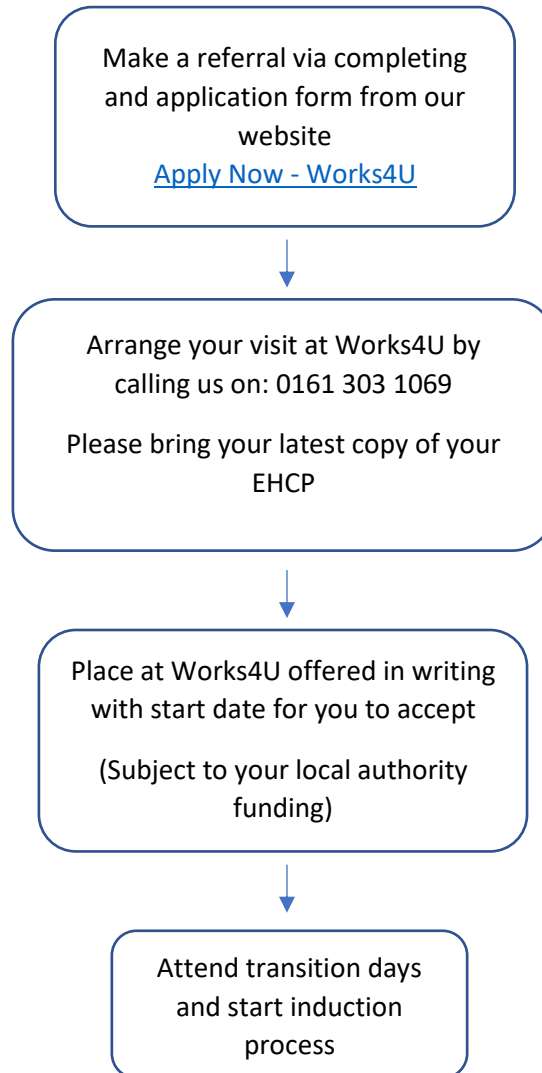
The LA will:
